Seeing God in Everything

While on a walk the other day, I passed by a Subway restaurant. Seeing the restaurant reminded me of a time when someone who was ahead of me in the Subway line paid for my meal. To this day, that act of kindness has inspired me to find diverse ways to pay it forward.

A few weeks before my recent retirement, I had an opportunity to share an act of kindness. My city hires and trains adults to stand around the school grounds and help students travel safely to and from school. During my drive to work, I noticed one dedicated worker who faithfully stood at her post every day—regardless of the weather. (This was not customary practice for all the workers.) Last spring, I felt compelled to stop my car to thank her for her faithfulness.

During the week of my retirement, I saw her again standing at her post. Because I knew I would not see her at her early morning post anymore, I felt inspired to give her a token of appreciation. I bought a Christmas card and included a gift inside. The next morning, when I stopped my car to give her the gift, she recognized me from our conversation in the spring. I presented her with the card and asked if she was a member of a church. When she replied no, I invited her to my church.

That same night, the Lord placed upon my heart to return the next morning with another Christmas card. This time, I included an explanation that the gift I gave her (though heartfelt) could never compare to the incredible gift of receiving Jesus. I shared how she could receive this priceless gift and included some information about my church. I know I may not see her again, but I am believing that God will take the seed that I planted and allow it to take root inside of her.

It's not important who does the planting, or who does the watering. What's important is that God makes the seed grow. 1 Corinthians 3:7 NLT

The greatest act of generosity is to pass on to others the good God has done for us. Giving monetary gifts, extending services, and offering words of encouragement are fantastic, and this pleases the Lord. However, the most incredible kindness is sharing the love of Christ and inviting others to receive His eternal love.
