*Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. Hebrews 11:1*

A few years ago, I heard a simple story that stayed with me. It is about the unwavering strength of faith in what is hoped for, even when nothing seems to change. It is about a young boy who grew up on a farm and wanted a horse. He would often ask his parents for a horse, hoping his dream would come true.

His parents rushed to the barn to see what was happening. His father asked, "Son, why are you so happy?" With a big smile, the boy replied, "With all this mess in here, there gotta be a horse somewhere!"

For in hope we have been saved, but hope that is seen is not hope; for who hopes for what he already sees? **Romans 8:24 NASB**

This story reminds us that true faith involves holding on and trusting, even when nothing seems to change. When life's challenges make our dreams feel out of reach, we can trust God. He sees things beyond our view, and He urges us to remain confident in His plan. Our faith is the anchor that keeps us steady, trusting that God's answers will arrive in His perfect timing, in His perfect way.
